



## Trump Energy and Climate Actions

### The Big Ugly Bill:

- **Reduces the amount of affordable clean energy that could get added to the grid, leaving Americans with higher energy bills: Average annual electricity costs increase by \$110 per household; some states will see more than \$200 increases annually; gasoline prices will rise by between 25 cents to 37cents per gallon by 2035 and Americans will pay the oil industry an additional \$339billion in gasoline revenues.**
- **Repeals lifesaving tax incentives for weather resilience, energy efficiency, and improved air quality because it cuts federally funded initiatives like air pollution monitoring, cleaning up ports, home energy efficiency upgrades, and emissions-free school buses. More people will suffer weather-related deaths. More people will die or become ill with cancer, heart disease and other air pollution-related illnesses.**
- **Guarantees climate risks for Americans' safety and livelihoods including workers' safety in extreme heat, rising rates of preventable injuries and deaths due to climate change related extreme weather events like flash floods. By reducing the availability of renewable energy, it increases threats to the electric grid and reduces its resiliency.**

### The Big Ugly Bill does not:

- **Reduce utility costs for businesses; higher business energy costs will be passed on to consumers.**
- **Provide money for research into the mitigation of climate change leading to worsening climate change conditions and more deadly weather events.**
- ***The bill does not give tax breaks to working and middleclass people because it \*repeals\* tax incentives for cheaper renewable energy and \*gives\* \$15 billion in tax breaks to the fossil fuel industry.***
